The Board of Supervisors in session with all members present. The current agenda was approved on a motion by Straight, second by Kurth. Unanimous approval. Previous minutes were approved on a motion by Straight, second by Kurth. Unanimous approval.

**Driver's License**

The Iowa DOT requested an updated 28E agreement with the County for the ability of the County to issue driver's licenses, non-operator's identification cards and persons with disabilities devices on a permanent basis under Section 321M.3 of the Iowa Code. Motion to approve by Kurth, second by Straight. Unanimous approval.

**Engineer**

County Engineer Steven Struble met with the Board. Mr. Struble updated the Board on the K-45 Asphalt resurfacing project. The final plans were submitted to IDOT district office in Atlantic after IDOT required the County to add a bid item for vibration monitoring at two historic locations in Modale.

Also, Mr. Struble discussed the sidewalk compliance issues in Modale on this project. The County had designed the sidewalks with new detectable panels to be installed just off the shoulder of the roadway and out of the intersection radi. However, IDOT determined that the detectable panels have to be installed with the near edge touching the newly paved traveled way. This would stop a sight-impaired individual into the radi of the intersections and too close to the thru lanes. The County appealed this request, but it was denied by IDOT.

Bids for seal coating approximately 31 miles of roads will be accepted in the Auditor's office no later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

With business of the day completed, the Board adjourned on a motion by Kurth, second by Straight. Unanimous approval.
