Utility Towers

Robert Schechinger and Jerry Stueve met with the Board to voice concerns about utility towers being placed in the road right of way along their property without any notification from anyone. County Engineer Steven Struble felt it was the responsibility of the utility companies to notify the landowners. The Board would discuss the matter with Matt Pitt, zoning administrator, to see if anything could be written in an ordinance regarding these towers.

Handwritten Warrant

A handwritten warrant to US Bank in the amount of \$4,348.36 was approved on a motion by King, second by Utman. Unanimous approval.

Engineer

County Engineer Steven Struble updated the Board on the following projects:

335th Street HMA Resurfacing – L-20 to Nixon – Contractor has completed the base course except railroad crossing approaches and the L-20 intersection this week. They are planning to complete the surface course from Nixon to the Boyer River Bridge today and will be completing the surface course from the Boyer to L-20 this Fall if the weather allows. The asphalt work is going well. There are flaggers and pilot car and traffic is being maintained thru the project.

Centerline Painting Contract – Vogel Paint completed our pavement marking contract for centerlines, no passing, and edge-lines. Their hand painting crew plans to come in to paint the stop bars and railroad crossings in the next two weeks as the weather allows.

It was too wet for crews to repair roadway slough-offs until yesterday. Also too wet to blade or haul much gravel to roads. Crews installed plow brackets on trucks this week.

A farm to market voucher for Sundquist Engineering in the amount of \$2,680 was approved on a motion by King, second by Utman. Unanimous approval.

With business of the day completed, the Board adjourned on a motion by King, second by Utman. Unanimous approval.
