

**Notice of Intent to Fill the Vacancy  
on the Harrison County Board of Supervisors  
by Appointment**

Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 69.14A, the Harrison County Auditor, Recorder and Treasurer (vacancy appointing committee) intend to make an appointment to fill the vacancy on the Harrison County Board of Supervisors at Noon on Thursday, December 7, 2017.

Persons interested in the appointment should submit a letter of interest and resume to the Treasurer's Office at the Harrison County Court House, 111 N 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave, Logan, IA 51546, not later than 12:00 noon on Friday, December 1, 2017. Applications must be submitted in hard-copy. Residency in Harrison County is required at the time of the appointment, and throughout the length of the term. Further, residency in Harrison County for at least six months prior to December 7, 2017 is required.

The committee anticipates conducting in-person interviews of selected applicants, in the Board Room at the Court House, during the week of December 4th. All interviews will be open to the public unless requested by the applicant.

The appointment made by the committee on December 7, 2017 will be valid until the results of the November 6, 2018 general election are certified, subject to the following paragraph:

Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 69.14A, subsection 1.a(2), citizens of Harrison County may request a special election to fill the vacancy by filing a petition with the Harrison County Auditor containing the signatures of 747 eligible electors of Harrison County, no later than 14 days after the appointment is made to fill the vacancy.
